17 May marks the International Day Against Homophobia, Biphobia, Intersexphobia, and Transphobia (IDAHOBIT), to commemorate the date in 1990 that homosexuality was removed from the WHO Classification of Diseases.

The theme for this year’s IDAHOBIT is “No one left behind: equality, freedom and justice for all”, which resonates deeply with the mandate of the United Nations on the 75th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, at a time when LGBTIQ+ rights are increasingly under attack.
