The Polling Officers have informed us that one candidate has obtained the double majority required to be elected for the position of FICSA Executive Committee Member for Compensation Issues, and unanimous support for the only candidate for Regional Representative for Asia with full votes. Therefore as per Rule 34 of the Rules of Procedure of the Council in the FICSA Statutes, the postal votes will be closed today.

- 1. Position of Member for Compensation issues (mandate until Feb 2024)**
 - Mr. Imed Zabaar, IAEA Vienna – elected through double majority
- 2. Regional Representative for Asia (mandate until Feb 2023)**
 - Mr. Ritesh Singh, WHO/SEARO New Delhi – elected through double majority
